



Root Canal Treatment

What is it?

Root canal treatment is the procedure required when the blood and nerve supply in a tooth becomes infected through decay or injury.

What does it involve?

It involves the removal of all infection from the root canals. The root canals are then thoroughly cleaned and prepared ready for filling

What if I do not have this treatment?

The alternative is to have the tooth extracted because once the nerve has been destroyed by infection it cannot heal. An abscess or a cyst may then develop.

Will the tooth be safe after treatment?

Yes. However, under some circumstances, a crown may be necessary to help protect the weakened tooth.
